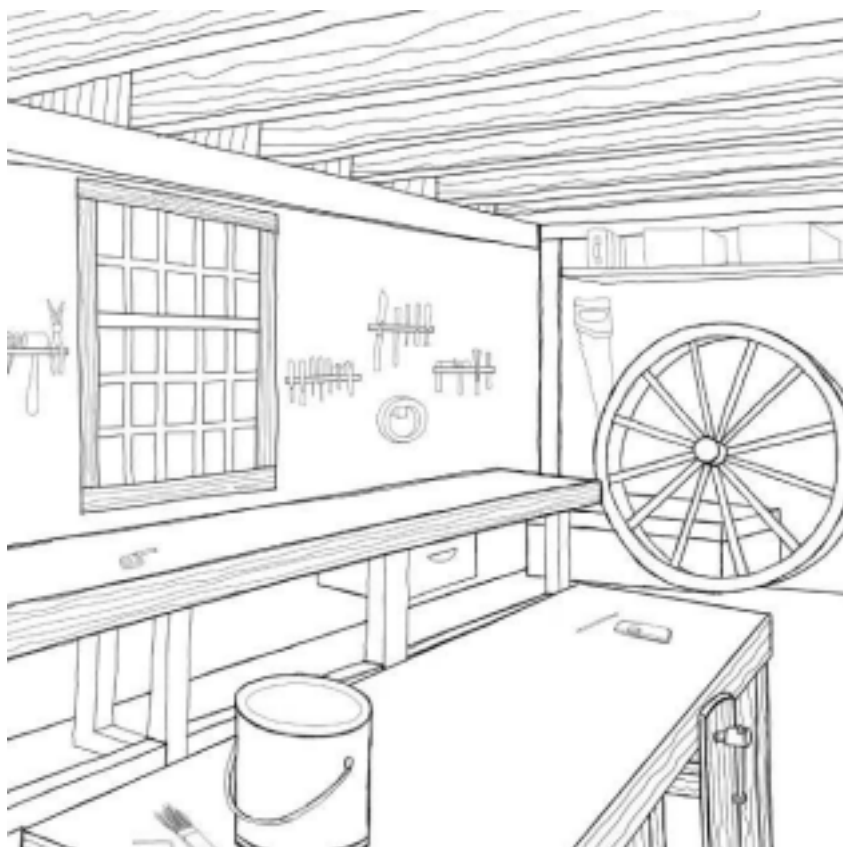

Prayer of St. Francis

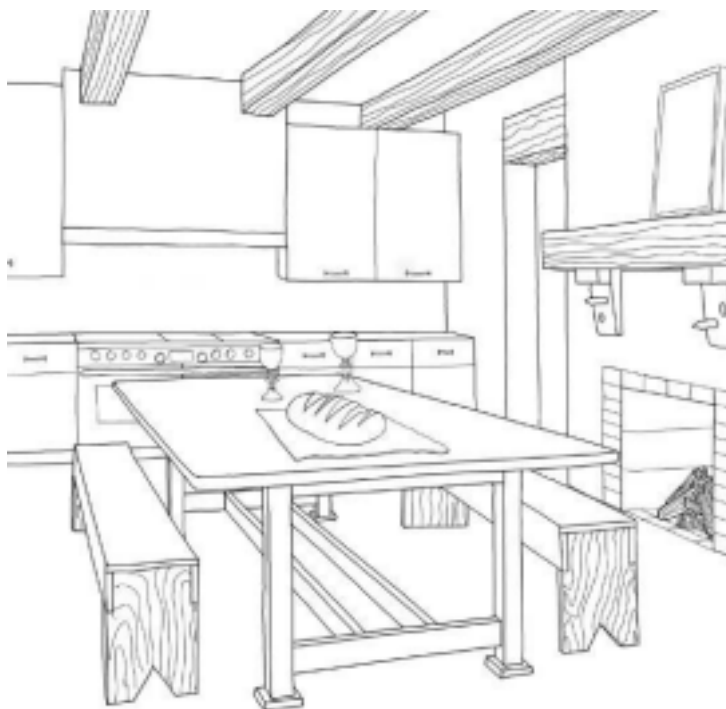

The Kitchen

The Kitchen is where we come to get our sustenance. Our Father gives us daily bread in three ways. Provision for our physical, emotion, and relational "today" needs (Luke 11:9-10). Prescription from God's Word that specically guides us today (Matthew 4:2-4). Perspective on how to leverage our circumstances to fulll our

God-given call for today (John 4:31-35). Finally, the abiding Presence of God (Father, Son, and Spirit) is the ultimate source of our physical, emotional, spiritual, and relational thriving no matter the situation (John 6:35, Luke 11:13). In addition to praying for your daily bread, pray for "our daily bread." Petition for the needs of others...and even for how you might be part of God's plan (Luke 11:5-10).

**"Lead us not into Temptation, but
Deliver us From the Evil one"**

We live in a fallen world - both tempted and attacked. Tempted by "the world, the esh, and the devil." Yet let us remember that our

Father does not tempt us to do evil (James 1:13). Instead, we are able to ask our Father to give us heavenly wisdom, self-control, and even divine protection that we might not sin, nor be overcome. We also have authority to rebuke Satan and all evil spirits in the name of Jesus Christ. Entering into the Mud Room means preparing to be sent out, “like sheep among wolves” (Matthew 10:16), yet clothed in His mighty armor (Ephesians 6:10-18).
